The Child's Godparents / Sponsors

The godparents are present to profess the Church's Faith, in which the child is being baptized. Therefore, in order to be appointed as godparent, the person must be suitable for this role and have the intention of fulfilling it. Only one godparent is required, but two may serve as sponsors as long as one is a woman and the other a man. Sponsors are expected to be able to lead by example, to support the child's faith development, and to assist the parents in their task as the primary educators of their children in the faith. Therefore, for the good of the child, sponsors must be:

- Fully initiated in to the Catholic Church by Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion
- A registered and active member of a Catholic parish responsibly and joyfully living their faith
- Married in the Catholic Church, if married (note: married sponsors do not need to be married to each other)
- At least 16 years of age and demonstrating the maturity to accept this responsibility

Godparents who are members of our parish are encouraged to attend the baptismal meeting with the priest, if possible. Godparents from other parishes should supply in advance a letter a suitability from their pastor (this is typical and most parishes are able to issue these letters quickly upon request).

Please note: we cannot prepare the baptismal record if information is missing on this registration.
